Greetings Church Family,

The year was 2008. I was 21 and nearly a year into my first tenure as a youth minister in a local Southern Baptist Church. I was initially brought on to the ministry staff as a Youth Pastor, but upon discovering that I was not married, the title was changed to "Youth Leader," because according to I Timothy 3:2, a "pastor" MUST be the "husband of one wife."

To say that my time at that church was tumultuous would be a gross understatement! I served a church that just couldn't get out of their own way. I learned more than I ever wanted to know about the "soft white underbelly" of church politics. I was immature, lacking in confidence, spiritually shallow, and somewhat unsure in my own calling, so serving a church with a plethora of its own issues only made matters worse.

Near the end of my time there, I was invited by a friend to come and be a part of a Discovery Weekend at a local United Methodist Church. Now, prior to that weekend, I had very little experience with the United Methodist Church other than attending with my grandmother from time to time, so, as you can imagine, for a staunch Southern Baptist as myself, this was a bit outside of my comfort zone. Nevertheless, I accepted the invitation to serve as a "speaker" and "table leader" and invited my own youth group at my church to be a part of the weekend as well.

Unfortunately, when my pastor and deacons found out that I was going to be a part of this Discovery Weekend AND that I had invited our youth group to be a part of it, they were very upset with me and strongly urged the parents of my students not to allow their children to go because the experience at the United Methodist Church might be "confusing" for them. You see, the pastor of the United Methodist Church was a woman! Talk about someone who was definitely not the "husband of one wife!" My pastor advised me to decline the invitation, but I didn't! I went! And my life was changed forever!

I must say, for a bunch of so-called backward, hell-bound heretics, I had never experienced such love, grace, and mercy as I did in that United Methodist Church that weekend. I came in letting everyone know that I was a Baptist, but no one was fazed; I was accepted for who I was, even by their pastor, Deborah, who was not "the husband of one wife." She is a kind, loving, and holy woman of God, who has undoubtedly been called to serve and lead Christ's Church…regardless of whether I believed her calling was valid or not!

Throughout that weekend, I felt God's Spirit with me in a way that I never experienced before! I felt myself being "cautiously revived." In other words, God was doing a great work in my life, but I found myself clinging to my own pre-conceived notions of God, and this experience wasn't fitting into my own understanding of God. I fought it, but somehow, I grew. Then, on the last night, the table was set for Holy Communion, and I was invited to come and receive the blessed gift of God's grace. I sat in that pew and wrestled with my thoughts, "You' re not worthy to take communion! There's no way you should receive communion from a woman! Why are they calling this communion? Don't they know this is the Lord's Supper!?"

In a decision that changed the entire course of my life, I got up made my way to the altar to receive. I had to watch those in front of me in line, because I had no idea what I was doing! Pastor Deborah saw me and smiled. She pinched off a piece of bread, but before she could place it in my hand, I whispered, "Are you sure I can have this? I am Baptist, you know!" She assuredly whispered back, "Corey, at God's table, EVERYONE is welcome! This is the body of Christ!"
